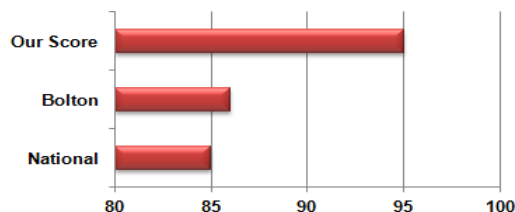
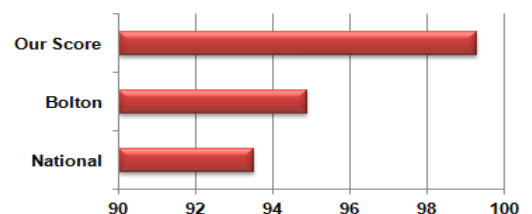
Are you a carer?
